invites you to join our living rosary to pray for the needs of the parish and the community. For the month of November, we are praying

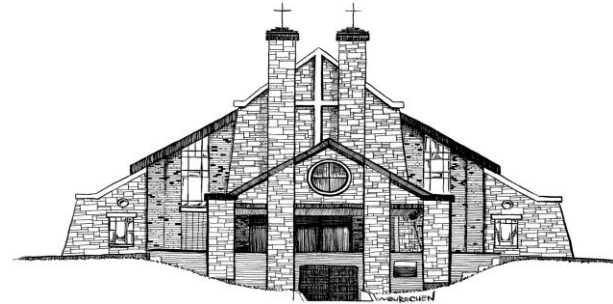
- for those who suffered in the clutches of drug addiction (Over 1250 Ontarians died from Opioid-related causes last year and the trend is rising.)
