

The current balance of the loan for the pipe organ is \$28,549 and we hope to be able to fully repay this amount by the end of the year or early in 2019. This has been due to the generosity



and support of you, the parishioners. Thank-you! The Property and Maintenance Committee has identified the need to replace the main church roof over the next few years.
