THIS YEAR MARKED THE 100TH ANNIVERSARY of the apparitions of our Blessed Mother to the children of Fatima. We once again hear and heed the message of our Blessed Mother at Fatima – the call to conversion and repentance for sins, the invitation to intense prayer, especially the Holy Rosary and devotion to her Immaculate Heart.

To continue our celebration of this event here at Lourdes, a holy hour will be observed on each of the next five First Saturdays (October to February). We will begin at 6:00 p.m. with exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and the rosary. This will be followed by a time for private adoration and the opportunity to receive the sacrament of Reconciliation. The hour will conclude with Benediction beginning at 6:45 p.m.

FIRST SATURDAY MASSES: Beginning with Saturday, October 7, and continuing until June, Holy Mass will be celebrated on the First Saturday of each month at 10:00 a.m. to honour Mary, Mother of God.

OUR LADY OF LOURDES PARISH LIVING ROSARY will begin the first day of October and continue to the last day of October. Each person who joins us will be assigned a specific decade and mystery of the rosary. He/she will pray the same decade and mystery each day for the entire month (Our Father, 10 Hail Marys, Glory be to the Father . . .). There are no meetings – you pray individually anytime of the day at your own convenience.

Remember: If you are praying the first decade of each mystery of the rosary, you will also have to say the prayers that begin it: the Apostles' Creed, Our Father, three Hail Marys, the Glory Be to the Father. If you are praying the fifth decade of each mystery of the rosary, you will have to say the ending prayer: Hail, Holy Queen. At the end of each decade the following prayer is said: "O my Jesus, forgive us our sins . . ."

On Our Lady of Lourdes altar, you will find slips of paper with little tear-off pieces. Please take the next one available on the sheet. This is your mystery and decade for the month. Also on the altar will be a notebook in which you can write your prayer intentions. Everyone who is praying the rosary is praying with all those intentions in mind. At the Votive Mass of the Blessed Virgin Mary at 10:00 a.m. on the First Saturday of each month until June, the Mass will be offered for those intentions as well.
