

**PRAY TO END ABORTION:** Abortion is a major problem all over the 40 DAYS FOR LIFE. world, with millions of lives being terminated every year. This is especially a tragic problem in Canada as there are no abortion laws whatsoever, which

means a child's life can be taken away even days before birth!
